Dear Zwingli Church Family,

June is Pride month. A month where we celebrate around the globe the lives of the LGBTQIA+ community. LGBTQIA+ stands for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, Intersex, Asexual, + those who are questioning and others who don't fit into the standard heteronormative ideologies of society. It seems only appropriate during the month of June we are finalizing the Open and Affirming (ONA) covenant for Zwingli, before the adoption of the ONA covenant this fall. For it is by adopting this covenant that we can extend a radical and extravagant welcome to ALL of God's people.

On June 13 you are invited to an in-person class to talk about ways Zwingli might implement the Open and Affirming covenant into the life of the church. What can we expect? How will Zwingli UCC be different? Will it be different, or is this going to go away once we approve the covenant? That day, Pastor Butch and I will lead a discussion, answer questions, and introduce the ONA implementation team to you. This is a great time to ask questions, voice concerns, and be in prayerful consideration of the way forward with the ONA covenant.

On June 15, you are invited to our regular church council meeting, where the ONA covenant will be presented for approval by the council. This is also a time for you to voice your support and your concerns to the council. I encourage you to be at this meeting so you can be a part of the process. Once this happens, you can continue to ask questions to our ONA team members over the summer.

I know these next few months will be busy with graduations, Father's Day, Fourth of July, and vacations. Plan to join us as we will celebrate graduates and Father's Day in worship on June 20. I hope during all the busyness of the summer months you will stay connected to your church family. For it is by being in community together, and by sitting at the feet of Jesus we learn, grow, and deepen our faith.

Sometime in late August through September, with a date to be determined, we will have a congregational affirmation of the ONA covenant. This is where we decide if we are going to adopt this covenant as a church body. And of course, I hope you will be there for this special event. I say this because we are called to love ALL of God's people without exclusion, with an extravagant welcome that includes LGBTQ+ people in our community, and this is how we ensure that this will happen for our church family.

I hope to see you soon. Have a blessed and safe summer, and always may we practice the radical welcome Christ has shown us, by welcoming ALL of God's people.

Make a sunflower, which turns its head to follow the sun.

### What you need:

- Paper plate
- Yellow marker
- Scissors
- Yarn (black and brown)

### What you do:

- 1. Color the entire plate yellow.
- 2. Around the edge, cut out an odd number of triangles. Evenly space the cuts to form flower petals.
- 3. Poke a hole in the plate's center. String black yarn through the hole and over one triangle cut. Tie a knot at the back of the plate.
- 4. Continue looping yarn through the hole and over the remaining cuts. Secure the end. The flower should look like a wagon wheel with black spokes.
- Tie the brown yarn to a black "spoke." Weave the brown yarn over and under the spokes in a circle. Continue until the sunflower has a large center. Then tie the end.
- 6. Display your craft as a reminder to follow the Son, Jesus!

- 4. Remember, if you load the page before the stream starts, the stream will not pop up. You will need to refresh the page.
